Meet during the day, have dinner together, stay over and continue the conversation the following morning.

Inside or out

Our meeting spaces range from the oak-panelled Library for smaller groups to the light-filled Pen y Fan room for larger gatherings, with plenty of places around the house to break away into smaller conversations.

The Library opens onto its own balcony, while the Pen y Fan room is filled with natural light and views towards the Brecon Beacons.

Wi-Fi and presentation facilities are there when you need them. But the meeting room doesn't have to contain the whole day.

Take coffee onto the terrace. Use the gardens for a breakout session. Stretch your legs between meetings or simply give everyone a little time away from the screen.

Food brings people together

Some of the best conversations happen when nobody is looking at the agenda.

Good food gives a working day a natural rhythm — coffee when everyone arrives, something worth stopping for at lunchtime and, for those staying over, the chance to relax around the table in the evening.

From a good working lunch to dinner together at the end of the day, food can be shaped around the way you want your event to work.

Because an away day should still feel like a day away.





Stay a little longer

A productive day doesn't necessarily need to end at five o'clock.

Peterstone has just twelve individually styled bedrooms — eight within the main house and four in the converted stable building — making it particularly well suited to smaller residential groups.

Once the meeting finishes, there is time for a drink, dinner, the spa or simply the chance to relax together without everyone disappearing immediately into traffic.

Then meet again over breakfast the following morning, refreshed and ready for one final session.

For many teams, the time together after the meeting is just as valuable as the meeting itself.
